- Welds various items using a variety of processes (manual arc, tungsten inert gas, metallic inert gas, brazing, cement core drilling, sheet metal, steam-fitting, etc.) (e.g. safety bars, lockers, carts, steamers, tools, electric motorized gates, etc.).
- Operates manual or semi-automatic welding equipment to fuse metal segments, using processes such as gas tungsten arc, gas metal arc, and flux-cored arc, plasma arc, and shielded metal arc, & resistance welding.
- Travels to various sites as required to complete jobs; brings the required personal hand tools, safety gear & company issued items to service the safety equipment & systems. Completes paperwork (i.e. certificates, inspection reports, delivery receipts) before leaving the vessel/rig; gathers all equipment & tools before leaving the job site.
- Oversees & actively participates with the proper installation of fire detection and/or suppression systems.
