- Follows all state, flag, and regulatory regulations for the testing of Breathing Air & Medical Oxygen.
- Tests Low pressure cylinders; maintains licensing required to service Low pressure Cylinders; completes and documents the service per FPS procedures; sand/paint/recondition cylinders as necessary.
- Tests High Pressure Cylinders; maintains licensing and registration with DOT for hydro testing high-pressure system; completes and documents the service per FPS procedures; sand/paint/recondition cylinders as necessary.
- Follows FPS procedures by recording all services completed on proper documentation, and records all parts used during servicing.
- Reads customer order, work order, requisition orders; follows FPS procedures when accepting materials for drop-off; tags all equipment delivered directly to shop.
